The young ballet classes teach the fundamentals of ballet using creative exercises and improvisations with storytelling, while the more advanced ballet classes expand the fundamental principals through a structured ballet class. Students will learn proper body alignment, develop motor skills, flexibility, and find their own self-expressions through ballet.

The modern class is designed to develop the mind, body and spirit to be an expressive communicator through movement using technique as well as improvisations.

In their discovery of patterns, rhythm, space, and the discipline of ballet, they will find themselves in an exhilarating and supportive dance environment.
