

CENTER ON THE SQUARE ART SHOW

Frequently Asked Questions and Information Page

1) Who is eligible to participate in the art show?

Any member of one of the four Greenwich House Older Adult centers is eligible to participate in the art show. You must indicate what center you are affiliated with on the front of the application.

2) What are the important deadlines?

April 22		Art show applications are available
June 7		Art show application deadline (No applications will be accepted after this date)
June 24 June 25	Do not submit artwork before or after these dates	Artwork submission to the Center on the Square from 11:00 am until 3:00pm
June 28		Opening day for the art show
October 1 October 2		Art show has ended and artwork must be picked up on one of these two days from 11:00am to 3:00pm (there is no room for storage)

3) How do we contact you?

We will either call or email you, so please provide current and accurate information. You must provide a complete working telephone number and/or a complete email address.

4) Can I remove my artwork once it has been installed as a part of the show?

We ask that you only participate in this show if you are willing to have your art work displayed for the entire duration of the show. Because our art show is very carefully curated and installed, we ask that none of the artwork be removed once it is in place. The removal of any artwork will create unsightly voids and disturb the balance of the show.

5) Please note the below information as outlined in the Greenwich House Older Adult Network "Notice of Filming and Photography" policy:

- When you enter a Greenwich House event or program, you are entering an area where photography, audio and video recording may occur, unless otherwise stated.
- By entering the event premises, you consent to photography, audio recording, video recording and its/their release, publication or reproduction for Greenwich House use.
