

#### **ABOUT GREENWICH HOUSE POTTERY**

Greenwich House Pottery offers a ceramics program for every level of practice and discipline, including wheel throwing, handbuilding, mold making, slipcasting, and special topics. In our multi-week classes, you can get started with the fundamentals of working in clay in an introductory or beginner class, build on existing skills in a mixed-level class, or refine your style with more ambitious projects in an intermediate/advanced class!

The Pottery operates two well-equipped studios to support your work. Between our two Manhattan locations, we manage three handbuilding studios, three wheel-throwing studios, a mold making and slipcasting studio, one mixed-use open studio room, 40+ potter's wheels, one gas kiln, eight electric kilns (barrel and front-loading), three slab rollers, two extruders, one Soldner clay mixer, five de-airing pug mills, and a spray booth. Mold making, slipcasting, spray booth, and gas firings are only available at the West Village studio.

GHP West Village offers six clay bodies for students (porcelain casting slip, white stoneware, throwing stoneware, sculpture stoneware, red earthenware, and 25-pound bags of high-fire porcelain) and offers low-mid- and high-temperature firings. GHP Chelsea offers two clay bodies for students (dark and light stoneware) and fires glazes to cone 6 only. Both studios have a large selection of glazes, slips, and washes. Other educational resources include the Jane Hartsook Gallery, access to artists-in-residence, visiting artist lectures, and a lending library with books dedicated to ceramics.

#### **REGISTRATION**

#### Registration begins Monday, March 10.

10:00 a.m.: West Village classes are available for all current GHP students. 12:00 p.m.: West Village classes are available to new students. 4:00 p.m.: Chelsea classes are available for all current GHP students. 6:00 p.m.: Chelsea classes are available to new students.

Registration is available online. "Current student" registration is available to any student who has participated in a multi-week class with the last year. Adult classes are for individuals 18 years and older. Students must be registered for a multi-week class at the GHP location at which they intend to work and fire pieces. Those who wish to work at both studios must register for a class at both locations. Students may not bring pieces between studios. Students in off-site classes may book studio time only at GHP West Village.

#### **PAYMENTS**

Payment is due at time of registration and payment plans are available. Greenwich House accepts cash, checks, ApplePay, and credit cards. There is a returned check fee of \$50.

#### FIRING POLICY

All students are responsible for paying for firing their work. Firing charges are \$0.06 per cubic inch for both bisque and glaze firings. There is a \$1 minimum charge on all pieces. Students may only fire work at the location where they are currently enrolled.

#### FINANCIAL AID

Greenwich House Pottery is committed to making ceramics classes accessible to all prospective students, and offers need-based financial aid on a term-to-term basis, as funds are available. Applications must be submitted each term. The deadline to apply for spring term financial aid is Sunday, March 2 at 11:59 p.m.

#### STUDIO SESSIONS

In addition to class meetings, currently enrolled students can book four-hour studio sessions for \$10 per reservation (\$5 on Friday evenings).

#### Registration Eligibility

Students may only book studio sessions at the GHP location where they are enrolled in a multi-week class. The Pottery will not honor registrations for individuals who are not enrolled in a class. Please register in advance to ensure availability.

#### Studio Session Schedule

Studio sessions are available in classrooms when other classes are not scheduled, typically weekday afternoons, weekends, and in the dedicated studio session room at GHP Chelsea. See the full schedule for studio session availability. Booking and cancellation policies are on our website.

#### **GLAZING**

Use of the glaze room is free for registered students during business hours. Students should visit the "Current Students" section of our website to determine glaze room availability based on faculty glazing demonstration dates. Students may be asked to limit their glazing time during high-traffic weeks of the term. Those wishing to reserve the spray booth at GHP West Village must make an online reservation.

#### **REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS**

In-Person Classes and Workshops

All requests for refunds must be made in writing. All refunds are subject to a \$50 administration fee. For a 100% refund (less the \$50 fee), requests must be received one week prior to the first session. For classes longer than 4 weeks, written requests received less than a week and at least one day prior to the first session will receive a 50% refund minus the fee. For workshops, requests made less than a week in advance of the workshop will receive a 50% refund. Cancellations received less than 24 hours before the first class or workshop meeting will not be refunded.

#### Inadequate Enrollment

If a class must be canceled due to inadequate enrollment, registered students will be notified as soon as possible and given the opportunity to transfer to another class. If an alternative class is not chosen, a refund for the total cost of tuition will be issued.

#### Transfers

Students enrolled in classes are permitted to transfer to another class at GHP within the same term, up to the second week of class, subject to instructor approval and provided there is an available seat. Transfers to alternate terms are subject to refund and registration policies. Students are permitted to transfer between GHP West Village and GHP Chelsea studios prior to either term starting, provided that there is space. Transfer requests for workshops must be made at least one week in advance.

#### Late Registration

To ensure our instructors can communicate introductory information to all class participants, students should register at least one day prior to the first class meeting. Late registration for online courses will be permitted up to the second week of class. Registration after the second week of class may be permitted at the discretion of the instructor.

#### Make-Up Classes

The Pottery is not responsible for issuing reimbursements or providing make-up classes for those missed due to illnesses, substitute teachers, or other events beyond our control. Alternate make-up classes are not permitted. We do not prorate or offer studio time for missed classes.

#### **WEATHER EMERGENCIES**

During weather emergencies, GHP closes in accordance with the NYC public school system, as broadcast on the radio, 311, and the local TV news. Emergency closures are announced via email, social media, and can be retrieved by calling GHP West Village at 212-242-4106 ext. 5, or GHP Chelsea at 646-347-1699 ext. 3. At the Pottery's discretion, classes that have been canceled due to weather emergencies will be rescheduled or a refund will be issued as firing credit.

## **Mold Making and Slipcasting Classes**

Slipcasting classes meet for 9 weeks for 4 hours per class. Course pricing reflects this extended meeting time. Tuition includes plaster and slip.

Due to construction in summer, the last day to make new casts will be your final class meeting. Students may glaze their work through June 14.

## Beginning Mold Making and Slipcasting

Learn how to make plaster molds and cast multiple forms using porcelain slip. Get to know the qualities of plaster as you make 1-, 2-, and 3-part molds. Students will cover the basics of glazing and experiment with combining casts.

#### Get to Know Plaster Hump Mold Workshop

Focus on a one-part mold as an introduction to working with plaster and mold making techniques. On the first day, the instructor will explain step-by-step how to select a form to make a successful mold, then methodically demonstrate the process of preparing the mold and mixing plaster. On day two, participants will bring a simple curved vessel to make a mold, and practice mixing the right amount of plaster.

If you have ever wanted a specific shaped hump mold, your own plaster slab, or you're just curious about working with plaster, this workshop is designed for you! No previous experience with clay or plaster is necessary. Students should bring a well-fitting mask (N95 or better). All other materials will be provided. Please note: these molds are not intended for slipcasting.

## **Special Topics Classes**

#### **Surface & Glaze Techniques**

Learn new techniques for decorating on greenware, bisque, and glazed surfaces while considering form and composition to enhance your designs. This hands-on class will cover a variety of materials, including underglazes, terra sigillata, slips, commercial and in-house glazes, Mason stains, washes, lusters, and china painting. Whether you're looking to refine your glazing skills or experiment with new decorative approaches, this class offers a thorough guide to surface design. Some experience with clay will be helpful, but beginners are welcome.

## Creating Colorful Imagery with Majolica

Explore your personal design ideas by painting with colorful stains that do not run onto a tin based, viscous glazed surface. Students will learn to mix their own palette of colors and how to apply them, utilizing traditional methods including cuerda seca and looking at other historical references. Students should bring several bisque fired pieces (not just tiles) to each class meeting as well as good brushes for painting. Adaptable for all firing temperatures and clay bodies. Intermediate level.

#### Clay Inclusions & Novel Surfaces

Find new ceramic surfaces using a variety of experimental techniques that incorporate organic and ceramic inclusions into clay and slip. Create unique, textural surfaces for sculptural and functional work. Ideal for artists eager to experiment and embrace unexpected results, this class encourages creative risk-taking. Students should have at least one year of ceramics experience. A selection of materials will be available for students to try. Tuition includes \$10.00 material fee.

#### Solid Building for Volume and Gesture

Create dynamic, expressive sculptures with vivid volume and gestural form using the technique of solid building. This course focuses on animal figures, guiding students through the process of designing small maquettes or sketches, constructing solid-built sculptures, hollowing forms, and refining details to bring their creations to life. Students are welcome to apply these techniques to other sculptural forms and even functional vessels. Some experience with clay is beneficial, but beginners are welcome.

#### **Surface and Form**

Discover the dynamic relationship between surface and form while developing a more intentional approach to your ceramic work. This course encourages students to consider surface treatments from the very beginning of the creative process, helping to overcome hesitation in finishing pieces. Learn the critical role of material testing and how to safely integrate it into your practice. Surface explorations will include bare clay, washes and stains, surface activators, underglazes, and glazes, primarily at cone 6. Some experience with clay is helpful, but beginners are welcome.

## Composite Forms: Building with Play and Experimentation

Explore the possibilities of form by combining simple shapes-spheres, cylinders, bowls, and more—into complex and unexpected compositions. Using a variety of forming techniques, including pinching, coiling, slab building, and wheel throwing, students will create modular building blocks for creative exploration. This class encourages spontaneity, experimentation, and collaboration, inviting participants to share ideas and even trade elements as they develop unique sculptures and vessels. Designed for intermediate and advanced handbuilding and wheelthrowing students looking to push their creative boundaries.
