### *Pottery Director*

- **Pottery Director** (Caitlin Brown) oversees the vision, operations, programming, and community engagement of Greenwich House Pottery across its studios, educational programs, exhibitions, residencies, and public initiatives.

### *Education and Operations Team*

- **Operations Manager** (Ryan Rennie) oversees facilities, equipment, firing systems, maintenance coordination, ventilation, and studio infrastructure in all three studios. Supervises SPC's and technicians. Largely located at Jones Street. Ryan is also faculty at Chelsea
- **Manager of Learning and Student Experience** (Dustin Yager) oversees curriculum, faculty support, educational programming, waitlists, accessibility support, student and faculty communication, and overall student experience. Supervises faculty, liaisons, SPC's, and Chelsea TPA's 2.5 days each at Jones Street and Chelsea. Dustin is also faculty at Jones Street.
- **Studio and Program Coordinators (SPCs)**
  - **Chelsea SPC** (Wren Macdonald) oversees daily studio coordination, classroom support, supplies, technical and operational concerns, and student experience during class hours.
  - **Jones Street SPC** is a new position that will begin this summer. This role is very similar to Wren's position at Chelsea, with a more administrative and communications focus.
- **Technician and Program Assistants (TPAs)**
  - **Jones Street Liaison TPAs** (Anthony Rodriguez, Emily Woo, Michael Guerra Foerster, Sasha Milanese, Suzy Goodelman) support front desk operations, registration questions, student accounts, schedules, classroom upkeep, and general administrative support.
  - **Jones Street Technician TPAs** (Bowman, Keira Phillips, Rudra Ray-Schultz, Sophie Feinstein, True Arizola-Lyons) support clay, glaze, kilns, wheels, equipment, studio safety, and technical operations.

- **Chelsea TPAs** (Anna Honohan, Anthony Rodriguez, Jerry Lue, Meghan Stanley, Michael Guerra Foerster, Ollie Oliva, Silvie Schlein) perform a blended version of both administrative and technical responsibilities overseeing the studio as a whole.
- Some TPAs are also faculty or teaching assistants for regular adult classes, outreach classes, and one-time classes.

*Education and Operations workflow:* Ryan and Dustin share supervision of the Studio Coordinators, and the Coordinators are the primary supervisors for the TPAs. Most student questions and external inquiries should begin with a faculty member or TPA, or by emailing the inbox at either Jones Street or Chelsea.

#### ***Outreach & Events Team***

- **Director of Community Engagement & Strategic Partnerships** (Jenni Lukasiewicz) oversees outreach programs, public events, partnerships, communications, and community engagement. Supervises outreach faculty and outreach assistant. Office at 27 Barrow, also splits time across sites and offsite outreach programs
- **Outreach Program Assistant** (Eva Conrad) supports outreach programs including Older Adult classes, youth classes, and events. Office at 27 Barrow, and offsite outreach programs. Outreach Faculty in multiple locations. This summer, Eva will be faculty at Jones Street.

#### ***Fabrication Team***

- **Fabrications Manager** (Victoria Shaheen) oversees fabrication projects and custom ceramic production. Office and fabrication studio at 27 Barrow Street. Supervises fabrication assistant (see below.) Vicki is also faculty in Slipcasting at Barrow Street.

#### ***Gallery and Residency Team***

- **Gallery and Residency Manager** (Kaitlin McClure) oversees exhibitions, artist residencies, gallery programming, artist talks, and Pot Shop development. Supervises gallery preparator. Splits time between 16 Jones Street and 27 Barrow Street
- **Gallery Preparator and Fabrication Assistant** (Brad Parsons) supports exhibition installation, gallery operations, merchandising, and sales support, and assists fabrication projects. Splits time between 16 Jones Street and 27 Barrow Street
